Closing the Homework Gap

Approximately 56% of school districts are providing remote or hybrid instruction to students during the COVID-19 crisis. This means that students learning from home need access to the internet and laptops or tablets.

The American Rescue Plan is helping close the homework gap by providing **\$7.1** billion in funding for:

- Laptops and tablets for students to do their school work
- Wi-Fi hotspots for students to connect to the internet
